

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

- CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Q: Why can't "I just follow my conscience" ?

A: We often hear people saying "I don't need any guidance from anyone because I just follow my conscience." They claim that their conscience will tell them what is true or false, right or wrong. But what they are really doing is just following their feelings or personal preferences, regardless of what may be the right or moral thing to do. Conscience is a unique faculty or power given to us by God to guide us to what is good, right, true and just. The purpose of conscience is to lead a person to the truth. It is a person's "most secret core and sanctuary" where a person can sense the inner voice of God calling them "to love and to do what is good and avoid evil" (CCC#1776). First we should have an informed conscience by learning right and wrong in the light of the Sacred Scriptures as interpreted by the teaching authority given to the Church. If we do not inform our conscience, then it won't be dependable and trustworthy. The Catechism reminds us that "the education of the conscience is a lifelong task." We do this by studying Sacred Scripture, by knowing the moral teachings of the Church and our Christian tradition, and through prayer.

The 2020 Theme is “THEY SHOWED US UNUSUAL KINDNESS” (cf. Acts 28:2). The focus for prayer on DAY 8 is Generosity: Receiving and Giving. “The father of Publius lay sick in bed with fever and dysentery. Paul visited him and cured him by praying and putting his hands on him. After this happened, the rest of the people on the island who had diseases also came and were cured. They bestowed many honors on us, and when we were about to sail, they put on board all the provisions we needed”. (Acts 28:8-10)

This story is full of giving and receiving: Paul received unusual kindness from the islanders [Malta]; Paul gives healing to the father of Publius and others; having lost everything in the storm, the 276 receive abundant provisions as they set sail. As Christians we are called to unusual kindness. But in order to give we must first learn to receive – from Christ and from others. More often than we realize, we are recipients of acts of kindness from people who are different from us. These acts also point towards the generosity and healing of our Lord. We who have been healed by the Lord are responsible for passing on that which we have received.

Prayer: God, giver of life, we thank you for the gift of your compassionate love which soothes and strengthens us. We pray that our churches may be always open to receive your gifts from one another. Grant us a spirit of generosity to all as we journey together in the path of Christian unity. We ask this in the name of your Son who reigns with you and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

REPORT — #iGiveCatholic 2019 on #GivingTuesday [December 5, 2019]

2019 was the most successful #iGiveCatholic on #GiveTuesday campaign EVER! The total national donations were \$7,462,168.88 with 29,531 donors giving to 1,743 ministries.

In the Diocese of Lafayette, the total donations were \$418,303 with 1,222 donors giving to 71 ministries. The top two were Catholic Charities of Acadiana with \$201,693.50 given by 121 donors and Our Lady of Wisdom Church & Catholic Student Center receiving \$78,601.65 by 236 donors.

Here in New Iberia, Catholic High School of New Iberia received \$5,191 from 55 donors, Nativity of Our Lady received \$225 from 3 donors, and Dish-DeClout Social Service Center received \$225 from 2 donors.
